

Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

Alcohol

No retail sale of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every retail sale of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

This licence is also granted subject to such conditions as are specified by order of the Secretary of State under section 19A of the Licensing Act 2003

Exhibition of Films

Where a programme includes a film which has been classified by the British Board of Film Classification as 12 A, 15 or 18 category no person appearing to be under 12 (and not accompanied in that case), 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme.

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

The maximum number of persons permitted for the purpose of this licence is:

- Ground Floor 50
- First Floor 150

The means of escape routes shall be unobstructed during the whole time the premise is in use for the purpose of this licence

The film used in respect of cinematograph showings shall be restricted to DVD or VHS type only
